Cardinal numbers refer to the size of a group. In English, these words are numerals.

0	zero (nought)	10	ten		
1	one	11	eleven

5	five	15	fifteen (note "f", not "v")	50	fifty (note "f", not "v")

8	eight	18	eighteen (only one "t")	80	eighty (only one "t")
9	nine	19	nineteen	90	ninety (note the "e")
